Death has a way of grabbing our attention. When we encounter death, when death comes near us, it brings with it terrible suffering, grief, and pain. Even when death ends suffering, it still brings with it a terrible pain for those of us who remain. Death takes from us, it takes our loved ones, it takes our hopes, it takes our dreams for today and tomorrow. With death comes loss, the loss of our loved ones, the loss of our potential, even the loss of meaning. Death ends all, and no matter how much we try, we cannot make death meaningful.

In his book, "Where God Meets Man" Gerhard Forde writes, "For the frightening thing about death is that ultimately it has no meaning. It is the triumph of meaninglessness, of darkness, of nothing. That is what happened to Jesus. He "was crucified, death and buried". Thankfully, death does not get the final word over Jesus. "For it is, in the view of a theology of the cross only the resurrection that gives his (Jesus) death significance. He rose from the dead, he conquered the grave, the meaningless, and became the first fruits of the new."

When we gathered on Easter Sunday, we celebrated that death no longer has dominion over us; we celebrated the death of death because of Jesus Christ, who entered into the nothingness of death and in three days' time defeated it through his resurrection. All this he did for you, for you have been brought into both Jesus death, and his resurrection. This is the promise to which we cling in all things, but especially when death comes near, for we have the promise that death will not, death cannot hold us, because it has already been defeated by Jesus Christ!


