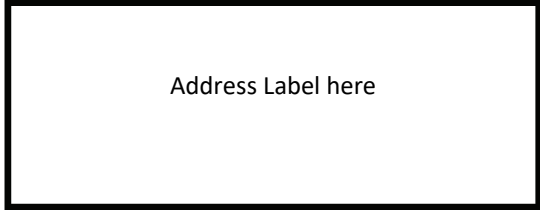

We found an organization that collects & distributes Bibles and Christian literature around the world to missionaries and people who want to know about the gospel. This organization, Love Packages, started in 1975 and currently sends 20 foot ocean going containers to port cities around the world. The distribution points have the capabilities to distribute the materials to thousands of churches overseas. Their vision is to see all of our excess, the materials that are being wasted, placed on the mission fields of the world. The cost of a 20 ft. container is between \$3600 to \$5900 and Love Packages is supported by free will offerings from churches and individuals. Since the beginning they have been able to send over 13,000 tons and seen thousands of people saved, healed and delivered as a result of this literature.

Our committee will provide boxes near the entry door for you to place your Bibles and when we get enough we will send them to their headquarter in Butler IL. If you have further questions please contact a member of Evangelism & Missions.
